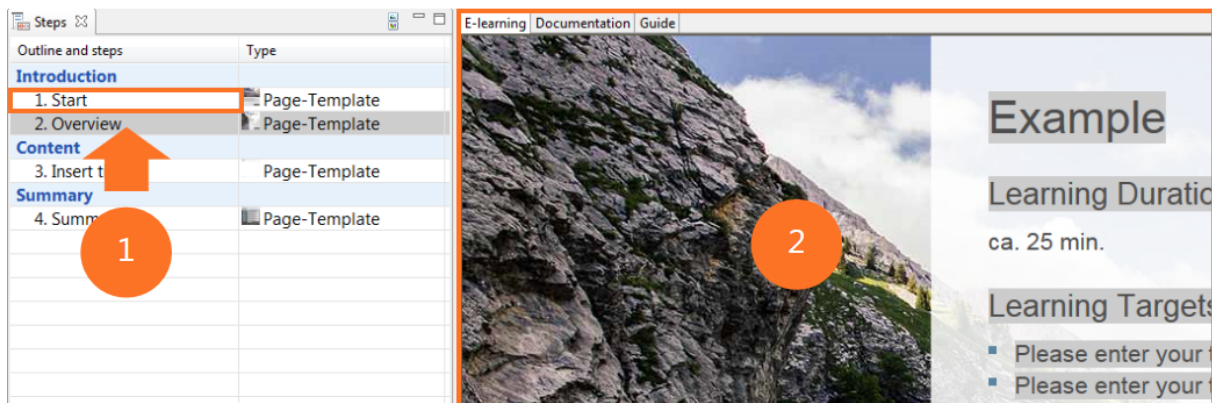


View: E-learning

Various views are available in the Document Editor – the E-learning, Documentation and Guide views. Keep reading to find out more about the "E-learning" view.

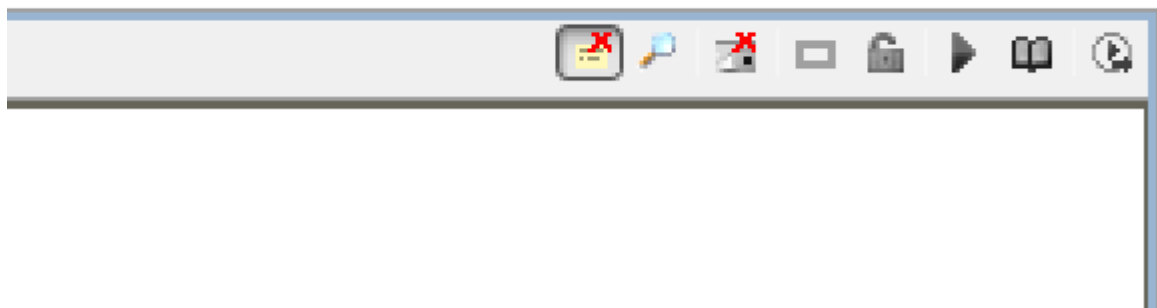
1 Step list and workspace

An e-learning is a graphically designed, interactive learning unit created with the goal of conveying knowledge – regardless of whether its content is IT-related or not.














Every **step** is displayed as an **e-learning page** in the E-learning view (similar to a slide in PowerPoint). This view shows what will be displayed in the subsequent e-learning product.

2 Toolbar in the workspace

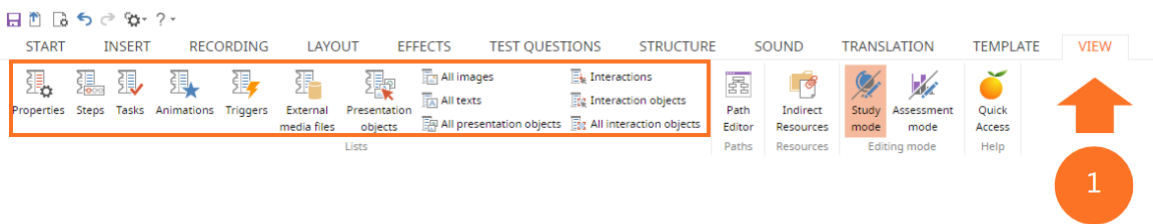


The image above shows the **toolbar** that is visible in the E-learning view. This can be found at the top right-hand corner of the e-learning page. The toolbar provides access to the following functions:

- Show  / hide  all memos (editing information can be noted on memos)
- Screen magnifier 
- Show  / hide  selected presentation objects

- Show  / hide  all interaction objects
- Protect presentation objects  or cancel protection (the respective object can be edited when the lock icon is "open")
- Switch to Play mode  (the button flashes in red during the preview)
- Switch the editing view between the Study and Assessment modes 
- Create an e-learning preview and open it immediately 

3 Displaying lists via the View tab



When creating an e-learning, you can find the **Lists** function group on the **View** tab. These buttons can be used to display step lists, lists of object properties, lists of tasks or lists of animations and triggers, to mention but a few.
