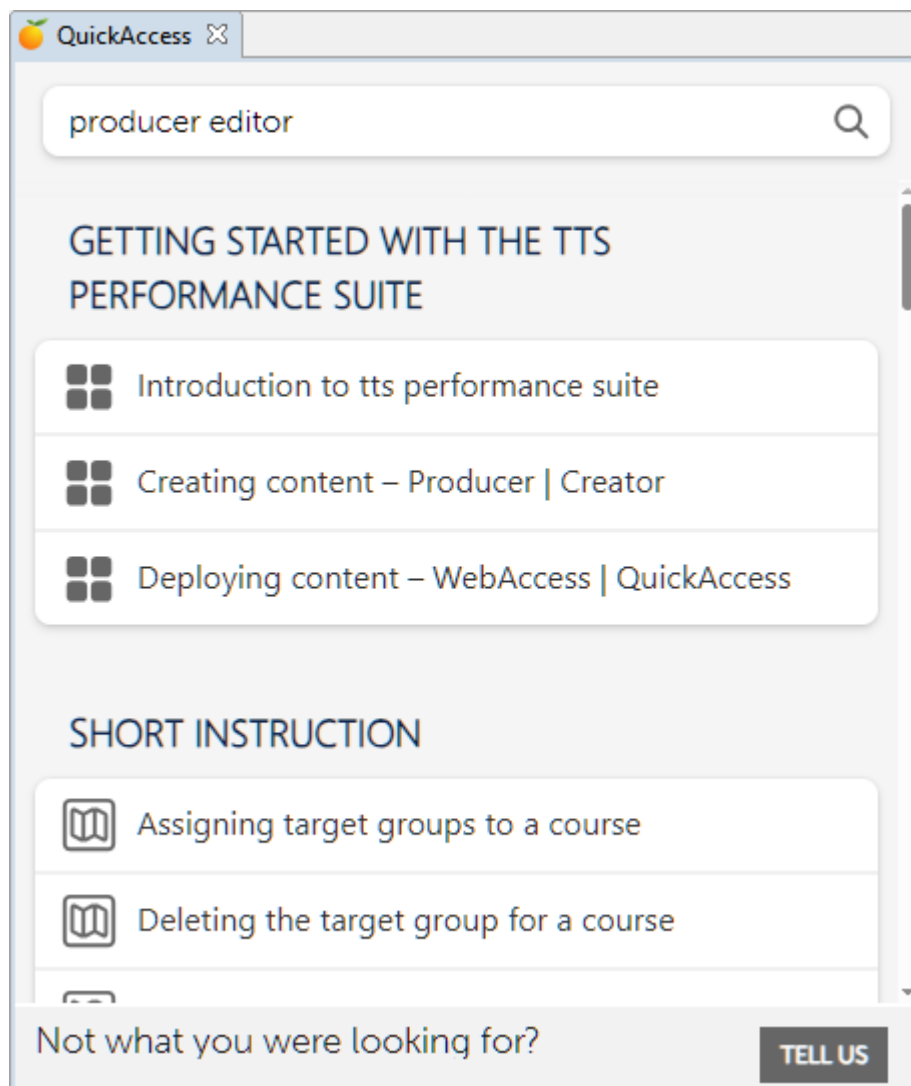


How to use the Help function

Keep reading to discover helpful tips on how to use the Help function for tts performance suite.

The Help function for tts performance suite is context-sensitive. This means that the content displayed matches the view you are currently in.



5 contexts have been defined:

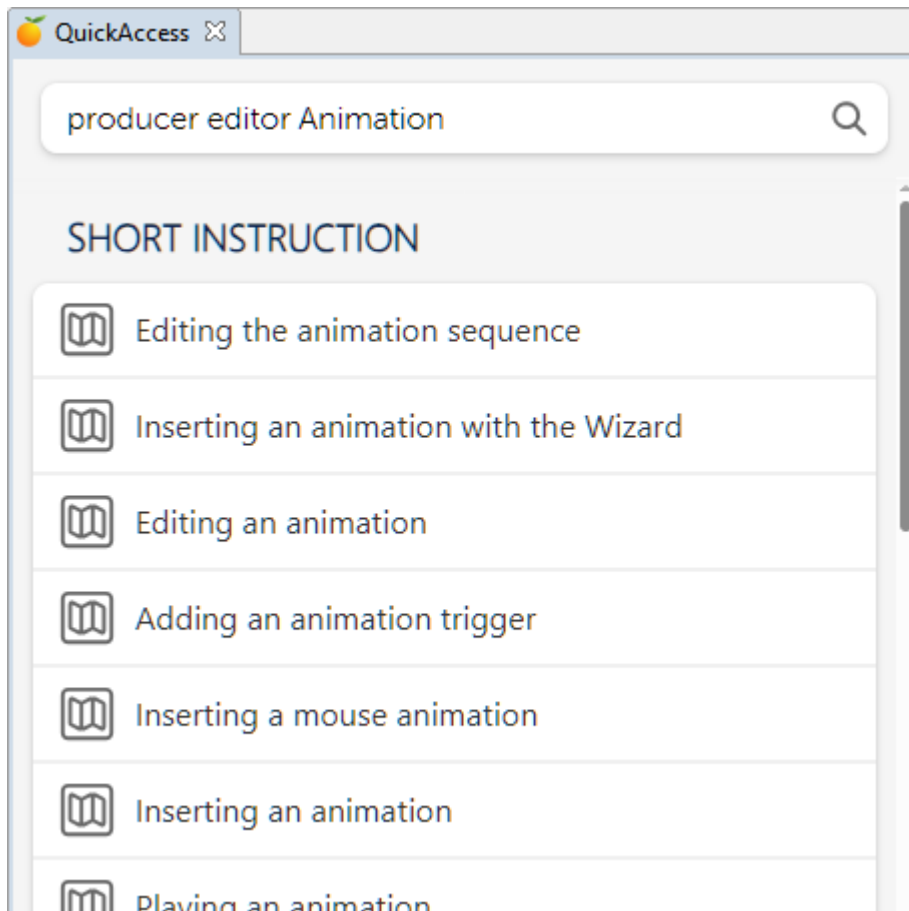
- **curator** for the Curator
- **producer login** for the login
- **producer editor** for the Document Editor
- **producer template** for the Template Editor
- **producer workspace** for the Local Workspace.

Help content is divided into 5 categories:



1. **Short Instructions**
This category provides step-by-step instructions in the form of a guide.
2. **Documentation**
The documentation provides in-depth information on a particular topic.
3. **Overview**
The overview offers an introduction to tts performance suite in the form of an e-learning.
4. **Concepts and Processes**
The Concepts and Processes category contains the documents associated with a particular topic.
5. **Help on Help**
The Help on Help category provides information on how to use QuickAccess.

To refine the hit list, you can use a search term to supplement the specified contexts, e.g. **producer editor animation**. You will then receive results based on the search term from the help topics for the Document Editor.



-  If you want to search in all topics, you can also shorten the context, e.g. **producer** would search all help topics associated with the Producer. If you delete the context altogether, all help topics for tts performance suite will be searched.
-  To access all content involving a particular tab or function group, simply enter the name of the tab or function group.
-  In the event that your search results don't contain the help you need, or a particular search term doesn't find any content, you have the opportunity to inform tts of this fact. To do so, simply use the "Tell us" or "Nudge" buttons.
