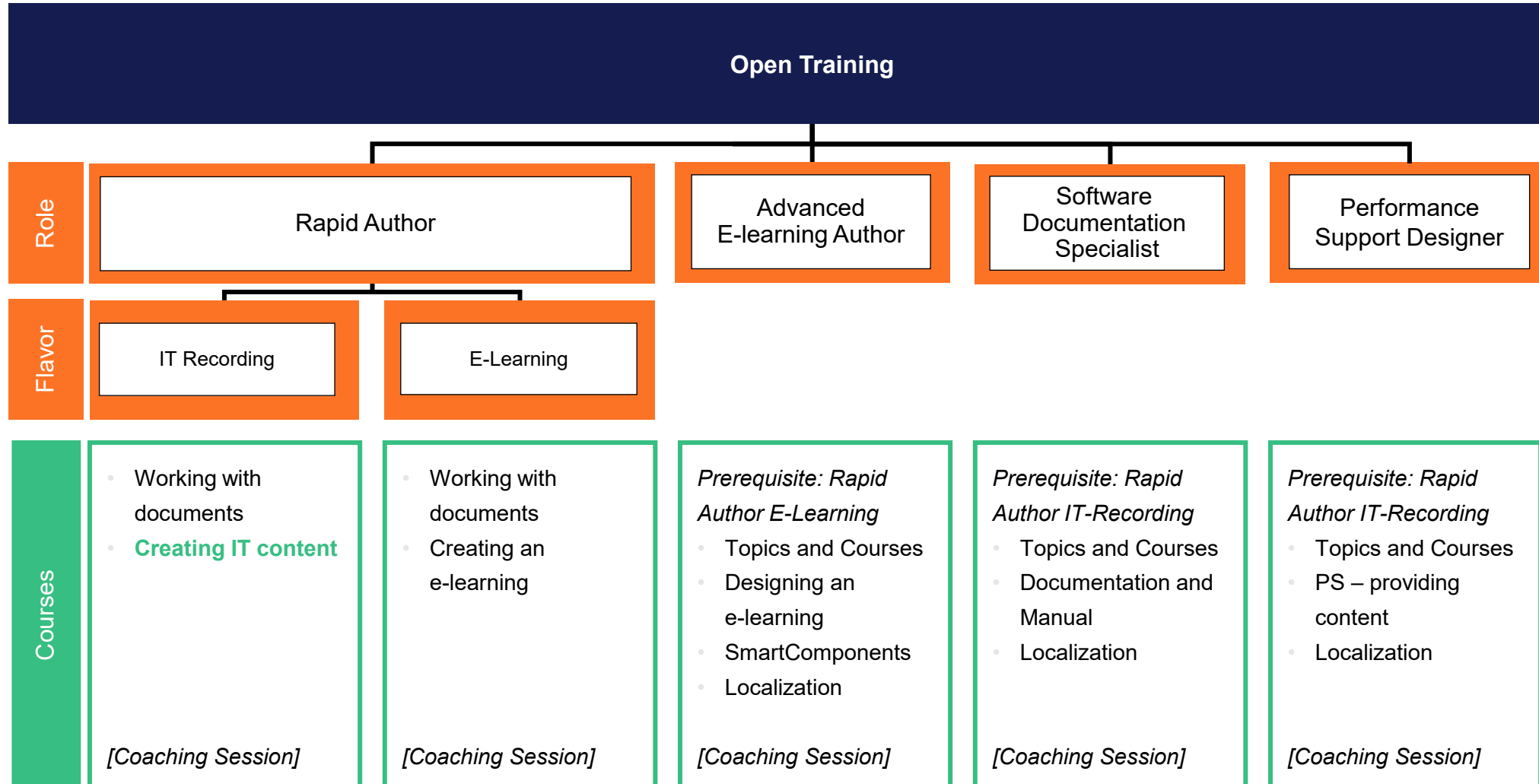

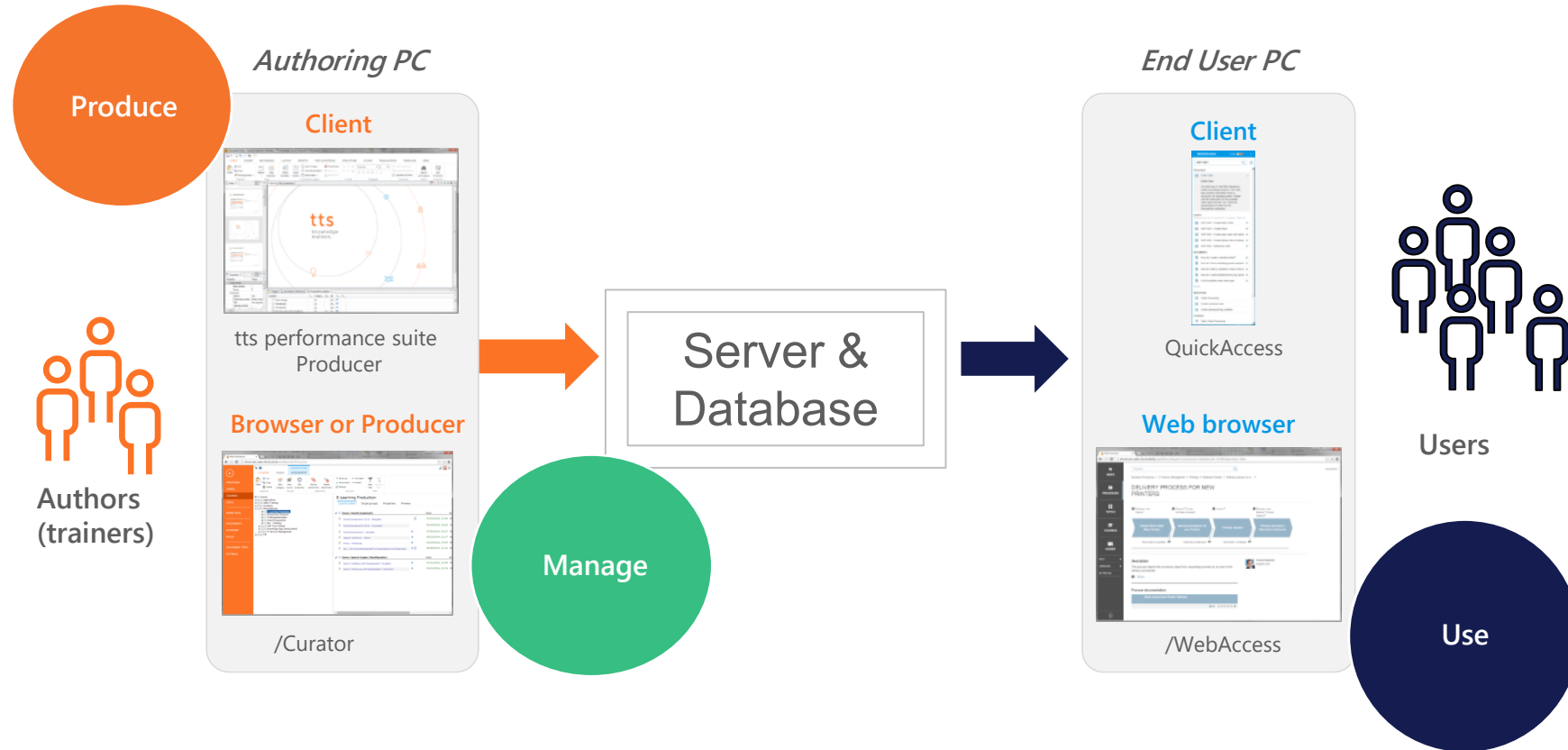

Structure of the Open Trainings



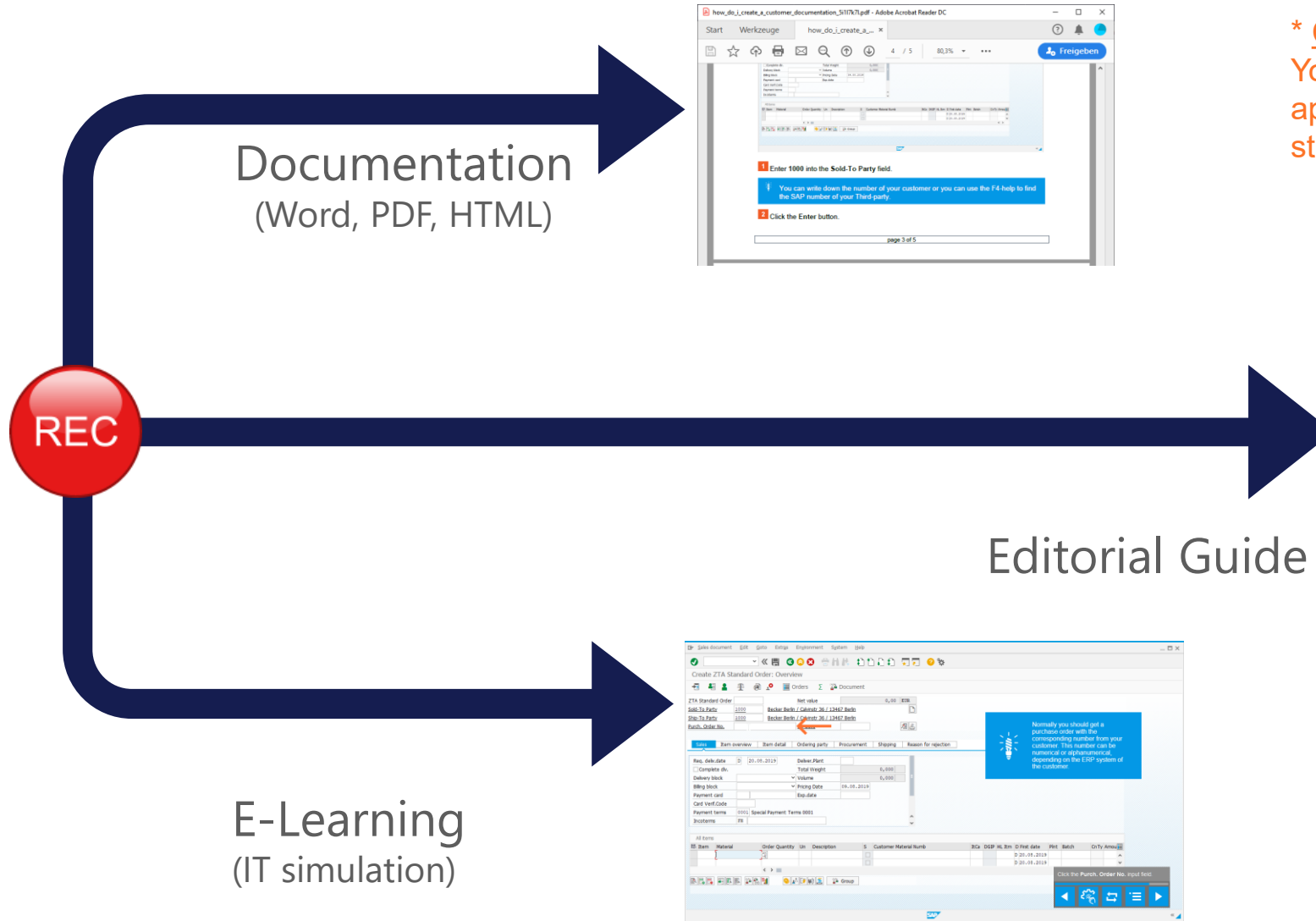
tts performance suite – simplified architecture

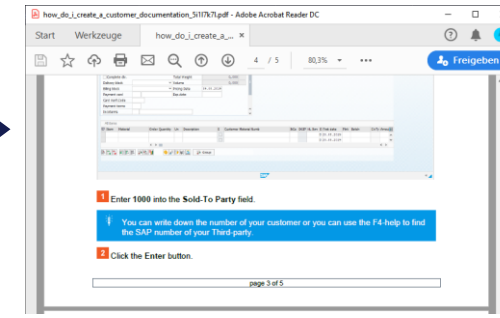


Publishing formats of Producer documents

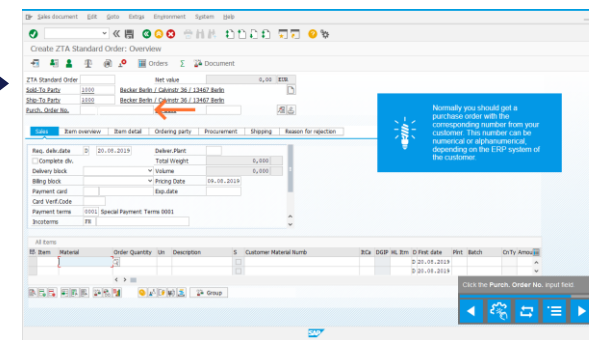
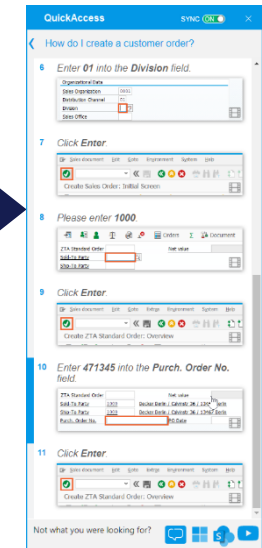

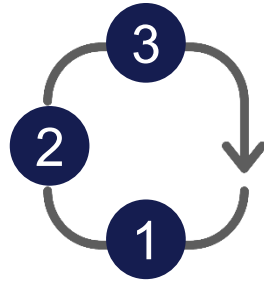


General tips and tricks for recording



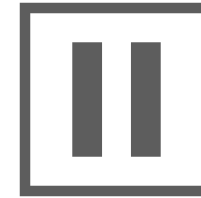
Switch off unused applications

...to keep them from displaying notifications at the wrong time.



You may add steps to a recording

... so there is no need to force yourself to record everything in a single go.



Do use the Pause / the Undo function

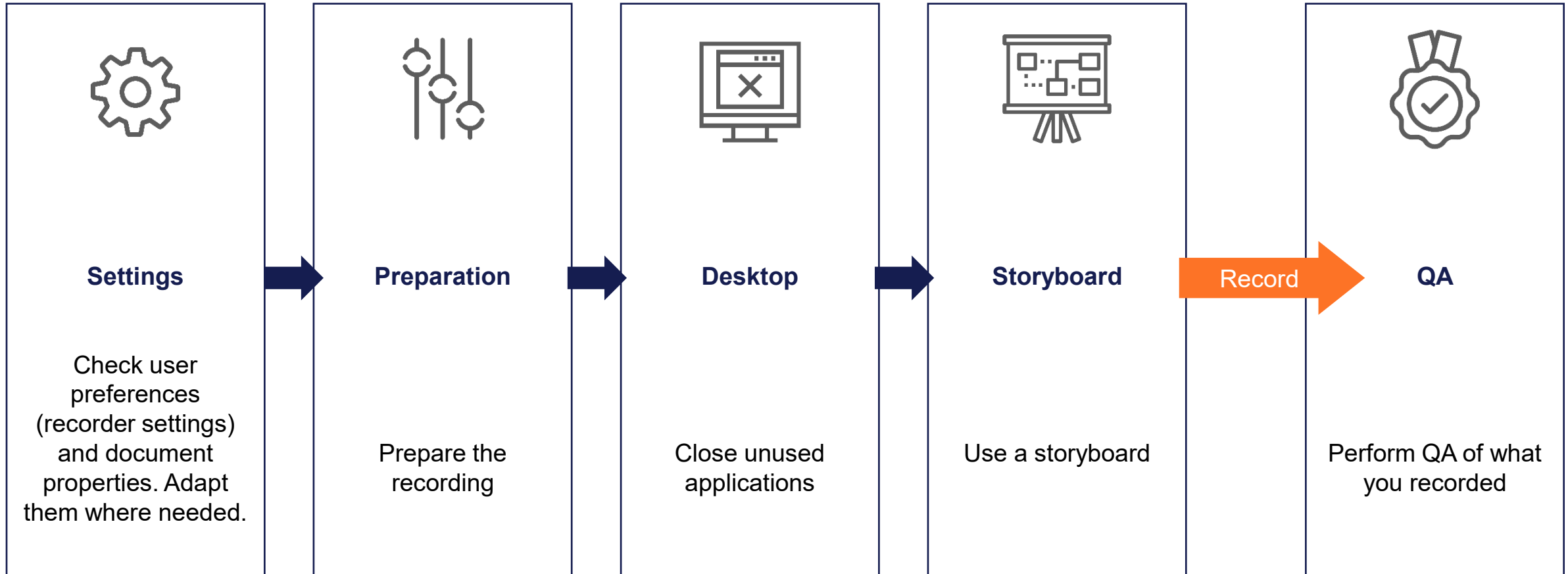
... to correct mistakes as they happen.



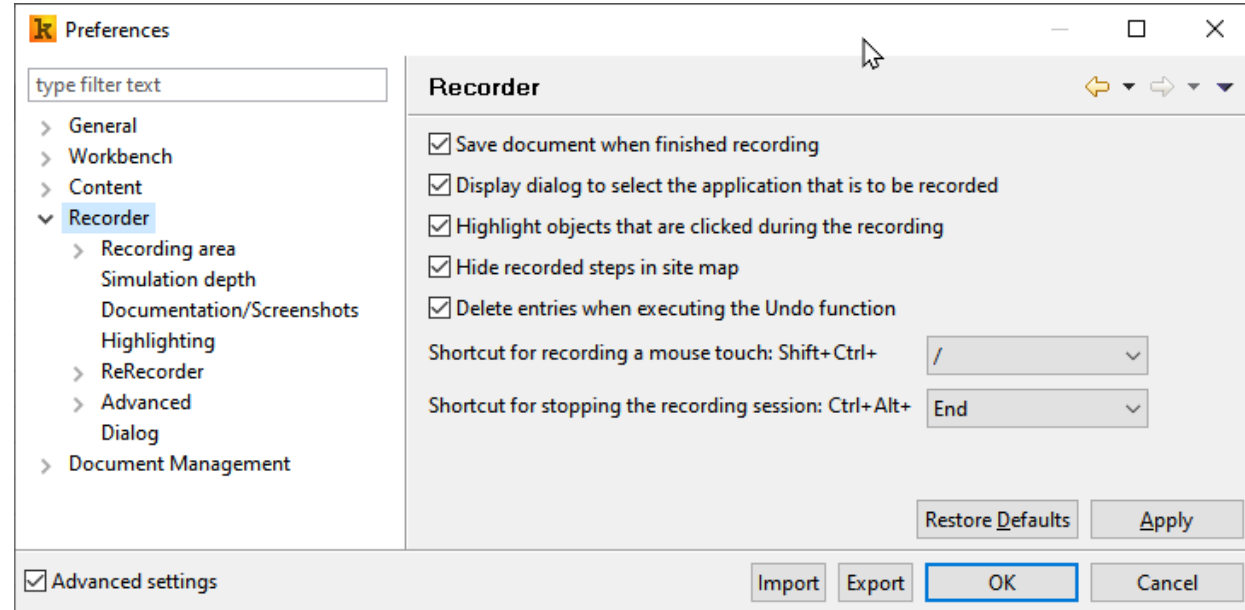
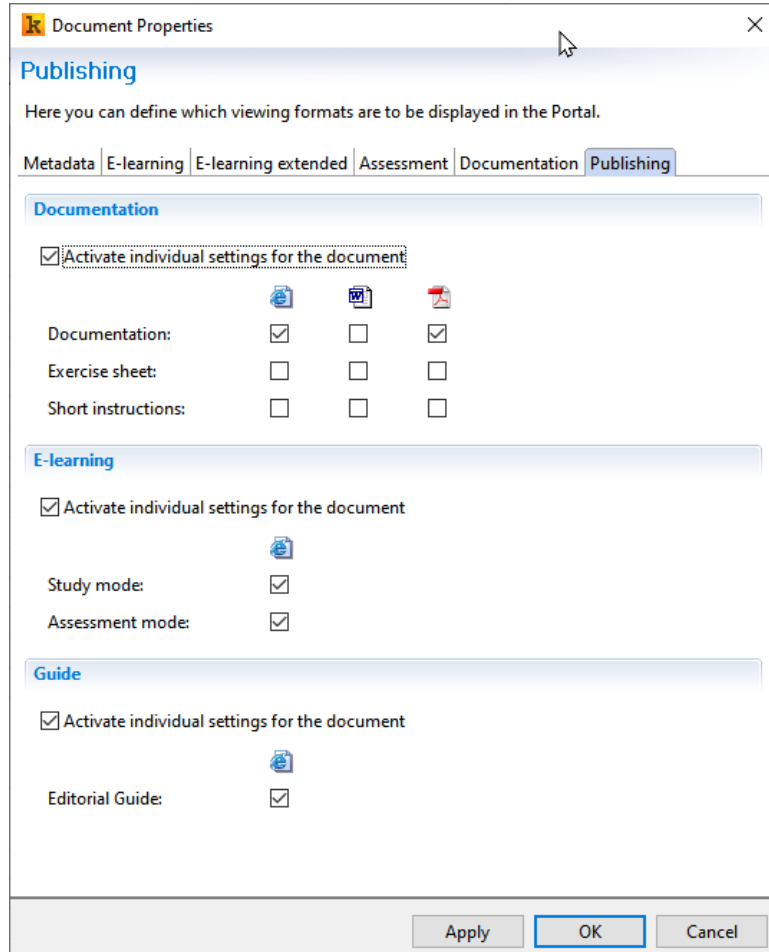
Mouse instead of keyboard shortcuts

Use the mouse to activate input fields or checkboxes. Do avoid drag&drop if possible.

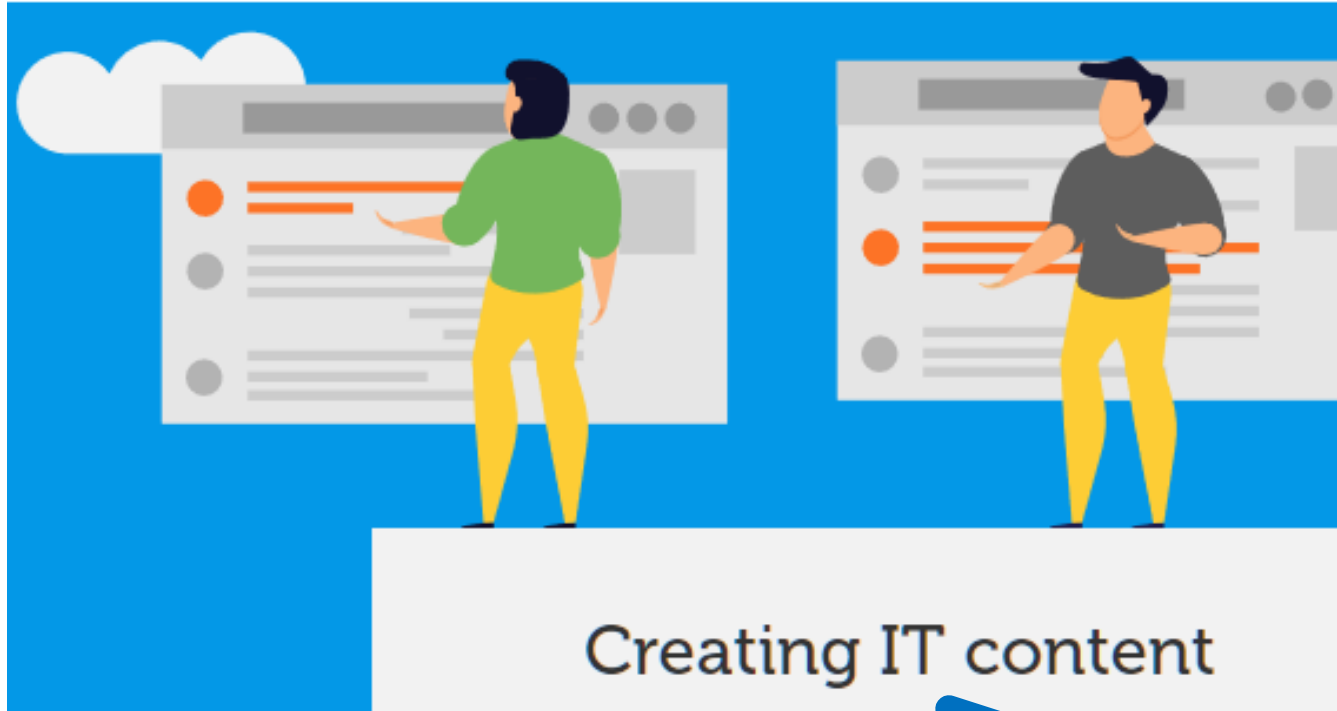

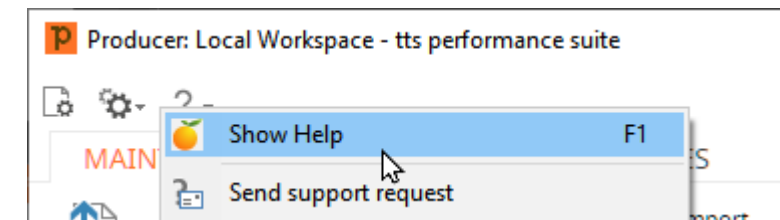
