AutoShapes

This documentation will reveal what AutoShapes are and explain the various ways in which they can be used.

When **designing an e-learning**, tt performance suite provides you with a multitude of standard shapes, lines and diagrams. The AutoShapes can be found in the **Presentation objects** function group on the **Start** and **Insert** tabs.



AutoShapes can only be inserted onto images in the documentation. And AutoShapes are not supported anywhere in the Guide view.

Positioning

Just like other presentation objects, AutoShapes can be positioned via drag & drop in the E-learning Editor. Alternatively, you also have the option of entering their precise coordinates via the object's **list of properties**. This method is better if you want to position the object with pinpoint pixel accuracy.

View

If the **list of properties** is not displayed, you can add it via the **View** tab by clicking the **Properties** button in the **Lists** function group.

Editing

You also have the option of double-clicking the object to edit it. The dialog that then appears allows you to specify a **name**, **fill color**, **line color** and **line width**, or add **effects** or a **hyperlink**.

It's possible to rotate AutoShapes that do not contain any text. This option can be found on the Shape effects tab in the Properties dialog.

Text

Text can also be added to every AutoShape. You can find the **Insert text** option in the context menu for the AutoShape.
