


Perspective: Login page and author roles

The perspectives guide the user through the interface of tts performance suite. There are different perspectives for the maintenance, editing and management of documents. Keep reading to find out more about the login page perspective and author roles.


When the program is opened for the first time, a query page appears if there is no Curator address or when several Curator addresses are stored in the User Preferences. Enter the appropriate Curator address or simply select one of the existing addresses. If you don't have a Curator address, your administrator or project manager will give you one.

If you possess a local (checked out) license, you don't necessarily have to log-on and can work offline instead.



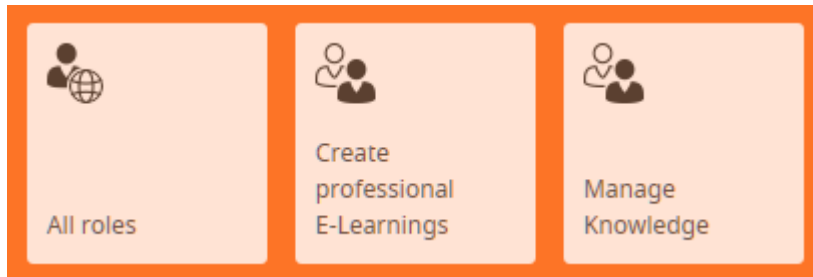

If only one Curator address is stored in the User Preferences, the login page will appear immediately upon opening the program. In this case, logging in to the software is not absolutely necessary. Your administrator or project manager will provide you with your login data.

Having successfully logged in, you can then select the role with which you want to operate tts performance suite. The selection of available author roles depends on the authorizations assigned to you by your administrator. The role selection screen will not appear if you have only been assigned one role.



- 💡 You can change the role anytime without having to log off or restart the program. Just use the **Functional Scope** button in the top right-hand corner of the program window.
