Useful documents and forms can be uploaded by employees to be consumed by everyone.




Make content attractive for your employees by enriching it with **text, images** and **videos**.







Differences between a document and a content building block

	Document	Content building block
Document metadata	Yes	Yes, created like any other document
QuickAccess		
Displayed in the hit list	Yes (just the title)	No (hide it via PSC)
Displayed in the structure	Yes (just the title)	Yes, its content is visible on the screen
Contextualization	Yes, can be done (context, performance support category and search terms are maintained)	No, do not enter any context information
WebAccess		
Displayed in the hit list	Yes (just the title)	No (hide it via document type)
Displayed in the structure	Yes (just the title)	Yes, its content is visible on the screen


