





# Indirect resources

Indirect resources are files that are attached to the Producer document – i.e. the target files for hyperlinks, imported PPT files (PPT import, PPT placeholders) or so-called external resources. Keep reading to find out more about this topic.

Indirect resources are files that are attached to the Producer document – i.e. the target files for hyperlinks, imported PPT files (PPT import, PPT placeholders) or so-called external resources. The term 'external resources' refers to media such as text or movie files that are loaded by a flash movie. The resources are stored automatically.


The list of indirect resources shows all the indirect resources used in the current document.



The **status indicator** informs you whether the file was found at the expected location. A


green checkmark  appears if this is the case.


The  **Search** button can be used to search for the appropriate file in the file system, based on the resource.

The **Storage:different** option is necessary for a text file if it is to be loaded by a swf file, for example. This has to be selected for this resource to ensure that the associated file is always copied to the correct subfolder. If in doubt, please do a product export to verify that the option was set correctly, meaning that the file can be found.

The  **Export** button can be used to export all resources for editing. The import can also be done via this dialog. However, ppt files and ppt placeholders can only be imported at the corresponding position in the Producer document.
