


## Path Editor

The Path Editor provides a graphical representation of all the paths stored for the e-learning. Keep reading to find out more.

The Path Editor provides a graphical representation of all the paths stored for the e-learning. It not only displays the main path but also all parallel paths and their individual steps. The Path Editor can be opened via the "Paths" function group on the **View** tab (or via the key combination HT+ H). New paths can be created via the "Paths" function group on the **Structure** tab. Please refer to the guide with the title "Creating a path" for further information on this.



Clicking a page in the Path Editor leads to the display of the corresponding step in the E-learning view, where it can be edited. The connections between the paths are also depicted graphically in the Path Editor. These connections can be edited via the connection tool or with a double-click.

The blue arrows symbolize interactions (branch or jump) which lead from the main path to the parallel path.



The yellow arrows symbolize interactions which lead from the parallel path back to the main path.

Whenever an arrow is selected, a brief description of the respective interaction appears just above the arrow, which is then highlighted in red.

The Path Editor allows you to change the connection between the parallel path and the main path (which is depicted by colored lines) via a drag & drop operation on the actual lines.
