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## The structured views in tts performance suite



To put documents into a context and relate them to one another, tts performance suite provides three structured views.

•Processes:


Allows for modelling business processes and linking documents to individual process steps

•Topics:

Allows you to store knowledge hierarchically, yet with lots of flexibility

•Courses:

Build learning curricula in chronological order, cluster courses using course categories (e. g. all courses on IT applications, soft skills, ...)





## **Working with Courses**






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#### Language picker (Drop-Down)

The input mask can be switched to another language, so meta data that are multilingual can be edited. By default, this affects the title and the description.

#### Mandatory entries are marked with an \*

Be sure to fill in all marked data. Also, be sure that they are set to the desired values, as e. g. the content language can be used to form variants

#### Performance support categories


That tab allows you to fine-tune how the course will appear in QuickAccess.

#### Context

Read out by the WebAccess & QuickAccess.

You may provide a context here to make sure the course will be displayed automatically in a given context in QA.

## Target group(s) for a Course can be added





#### **Target groups**

can be assigned to the courses. The course will be marked as relevant to them.

Example:
Accounting clerk
Production planner
Sales staff
Head of sales
Warehouse staff

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**Courses – Things to know** 

#### Courses – tell me more...




- Courses are used to group content (documents) together to allow (in)formal learning curricula, including additional material like manuals.
- Tests and assessments can be included. You may also define a mastery score which must be achieved in order to get a course certificate.
- Only released courses will be shown in the portal. If a course is embedded in a course category, that category (plus all categories that may be higher in the hierarchy) must also be set to "released" to allow the user to find the course be browsing the portal.
- Course variants can be created using the "New course" assistant (the new course is then based on the existing course).
  - The most commonplace variant forming meta date is the content language.
  - If you create a course variant, the wizard automatically looks for and adds all document variants. If they don't yet exist, they will be created as variants of the existing documents.

## **Courses – tips & tricks**



Best practice: Create course variants \*after\* the original course and all its assigned documents have been finished In the Curator, make sure you activate the correct tab (depending on which view you would like to work on):







## Things to know about topics



- Topics can be nested to your liking they work like folders that may contain as many sub-folders as you need
  - You may add documents to any level (even the root node) of the topics tree
     (in the courses view, you may not add documents to course categories, only to courses)
  - Topics cannot be sub-divided into sections (cf. courses) but you may create as many sub-topics as needed
- Topics may contain documents in as many languages as you wish we would advise against doing the same with courses
- Since the 2023 releases of tts performance suite, topics now allow for displaying content inline in the QuickAccess
  - so no need for extra clicks to open up a browser window







Things to know

## **Courses versus topics**



- Courses are used to define a curriculum, which can be subdivided using course sections.
- Due to their less flexible nature, courses are better suited to be turned into manuals.
- The new course wizard allows you to form variants based on existing courses, or create course structures based on existing structures (e. g. a course containing all documents associated with a certain role). This is not possible with topics.
- Courses should be monolingual (if you need the same content in a different language, create a course variant). Topics are designed to be multilingual.




**Export of Courses** (LMS)










