



Test question templates

This documentation will explain what test question templates actually are and how they ensure that certain types of questions are available in tts performance suite and that the questions can be modified.

1 What are test question templates?

The template and authorization concepts in tts performance suite provide the ultimate in flexibility when it comes to the creation of test questions. Depending on the project or customer requirements, it's possible to create any number of **test question templates**. Basic elements can be combined to create just the type of test question you want.

Templates for test questions are included in the *standard* tts performance suite package, but it's also possible to *create new* customized templates that comply with a customer's unique requirements. These templates define the appearance of various types of questions as well as specifying how they are to be answered. You should use the **Test Questions** tab in the Document Editor to create and edit test questions. There you can either access the appropriate predefined templates, or single-handedly create test questions without any template assistance whatsoever.

The standard tts performance suite package includes templates for the most important and frequently-used types of questions. These are:

- single-choice,
- multiple-choice and
- drag & drop questions.

A template for evaluation pages is also included.

2 Opportunities for template use

Templates can be arranged and combined differently to create learning and test pages. Three possible usage scenarios are described in these help topics:

- E-Learning: Building a learning unit with question pages (study mode only)
- E-Learning: Building an assessment mit question pages (assessment mode only)
- E-Learning: Building a learning unit with an assessment (stuy and assessment mode).
