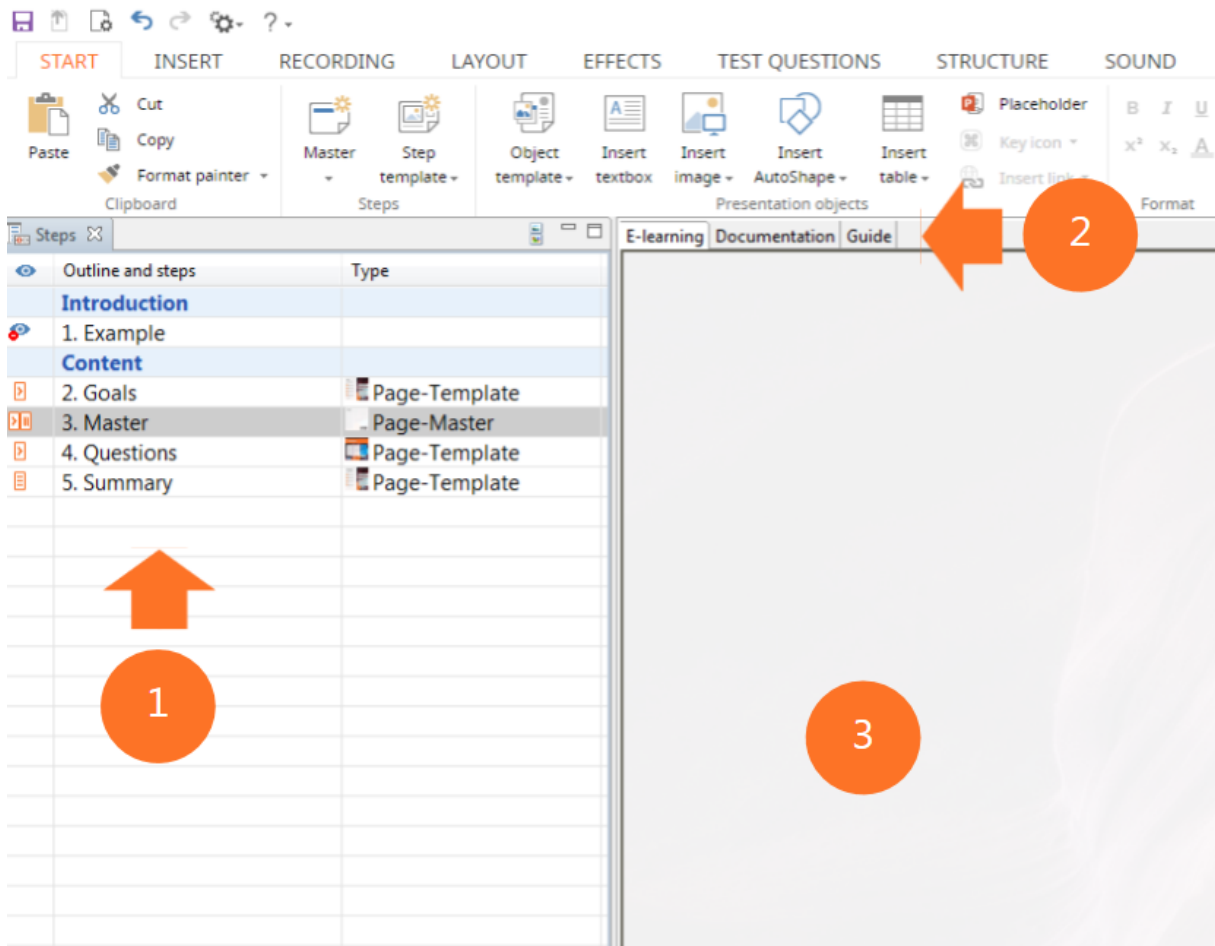


Perspective: Document Editor

The perspectives guide the user through the interface of tts performance suite. There are different perspectives for the maintenance, editing and management of documents. Keep reading to find out more about the "Document Editor" perspective.

The Document Editor is for the editing of Producer documents. The great thing about Producer documents is the fact that the **e-learning, documentation and guide** (2) media can be created simultaneously. The **views** (3) of the respective media allow you to directly edit content. You can edit and format text, create graphics or position and edit presentation objects via drag & drop. The views also provide access to context menus.

In the case of every document, there are also **lists** for special editing purposes, e.g. **the Step list** (1) depicts the structure of a document.



The **Step list** (1) and **view** (3) are always displayed in sync with one another. If you want a step to be invisible – either generally or only in specific exports – this can be controlled via the step's visibility. This is visualized via icons in the first column of the Step list. Whenever a step is activated in the Step list, this step also becomes active in the view. This means that the



e-learning page is shown in the **E-Learning view** and the content assigned to the particular step is displayed in the **Documentation** and **Guide views**. The User Preferences allow you to specify whether the insertion and deletion of presentation objects is to apply to several media or just to the one that is currently active.
