
Hamburger menu in QuickAccess

The hamburger menu in QuickAccess offers access to further information and provides additional functions for QuickAccess. You can find the details here.

The hamburger menu is located to the right of the search field at the top of QuickAccess:



The hamburger menu takes you to the start page (Home) and to the WebAccess views (Processes, Topics and Courses). WebAccess offers structured access to all the help and information provided. Processes and topics are displayed embedded in QuickAccess. The start page and the courses are opened in a separate browser window.

If **roles** are configured for QuickAccess and WebAccess, you can select these using the dropdown menu below. All relevant help and information corresponding to the selected role is then made available to you. Help and information for other roles is hidden or grayed out for process steps.

You can also use the function to **copy** the extended **context** determined by QuickAccess. This allows you to contextualize help and information so that it is displayed exactly at this point in the application.

You can also **share** the **link to** the current **search result**. The link is copied to the clipboard and can then be forwarded.
