

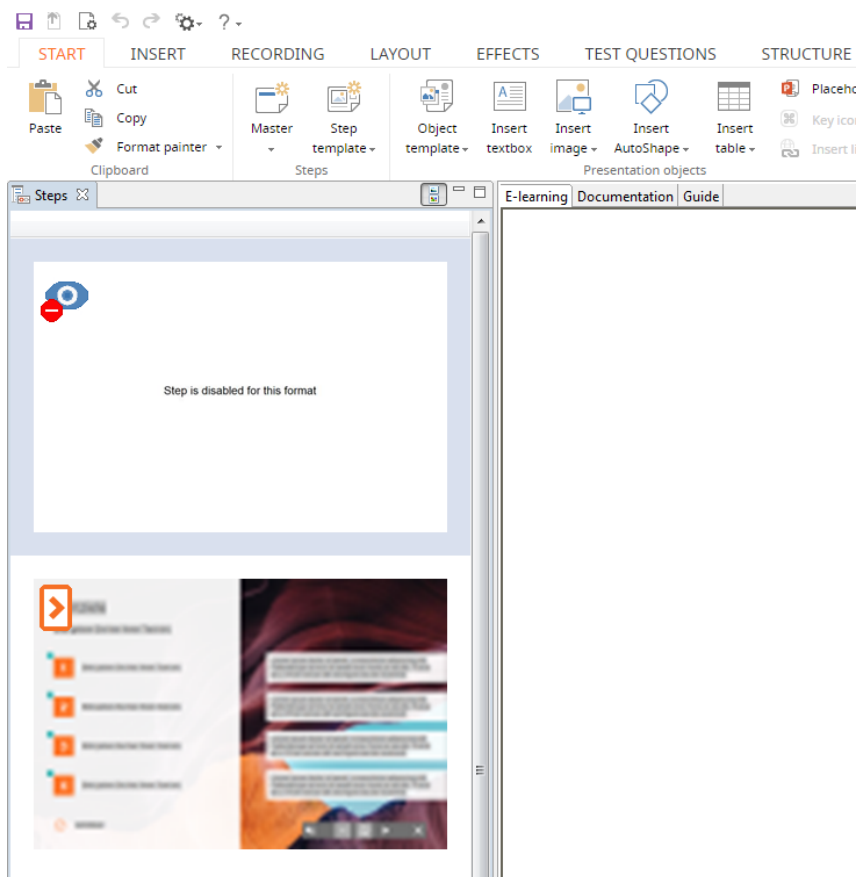
Step list

View > Lists - This document contains in-depth information on the various display modes (Outline or Miniature view), along with the settings regarding the visibility of a step or the functions of the various columns in the Step list.

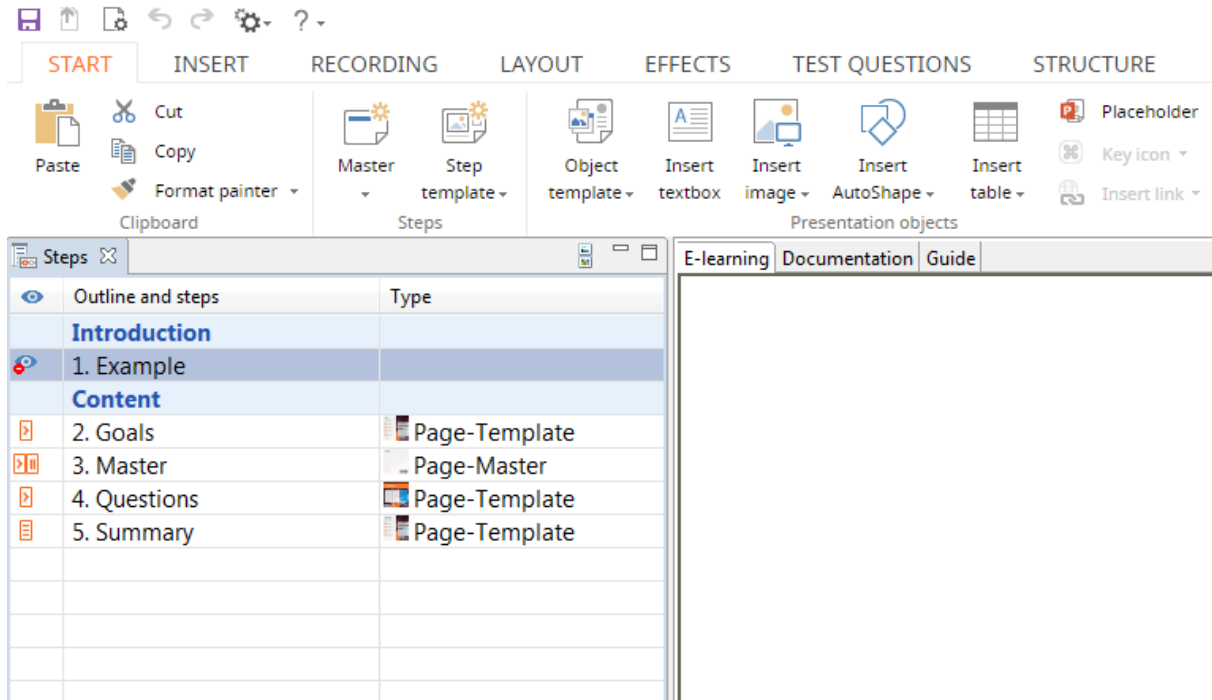
1 Switching the view in the Step list

The button on the right of the title bar in the Step view allows you to switch the display of the Step list. Two display options are supported:

1. Miniature view:

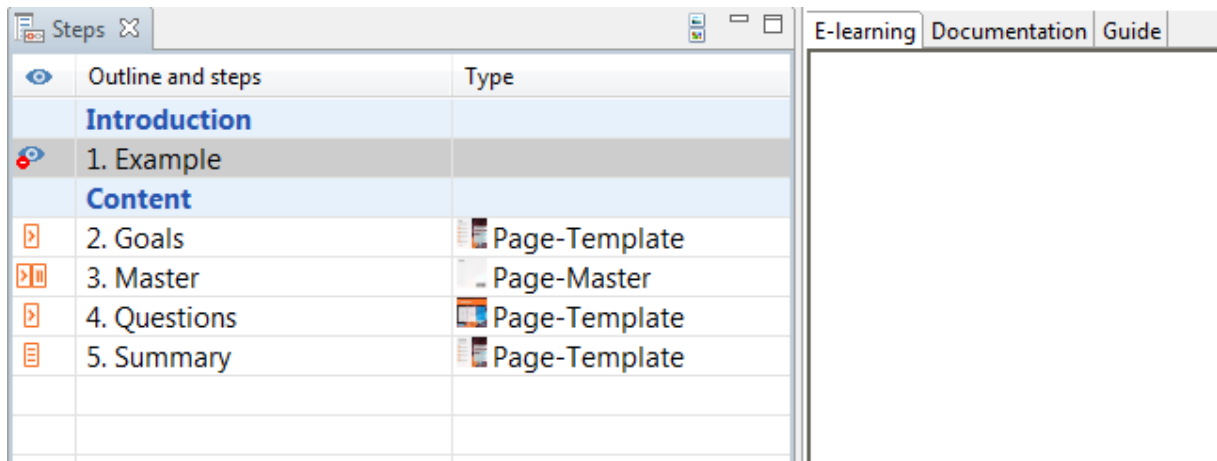


2. Outline view




2 Visibility of a step

It's possible to individually control (on a page-by-page basis) whether a page is to be visible in an export. The settings that have been specified for a particular page can be seen in the first column of the Step list.






Activating/disabling a step

If a step has been activated, it is also active in all views in the Document Editor. The **e-learning page** is shown in the **E-learning view** and the content assigned to the step is also displayed in the **Documentation** and **Guide views**. No icon can be seen in the first column of the Step list.

The "Disable selected steps in all media" function in the context menu for a step allows you to hide the step in all views and therefore in all exports (E-learning, Documentation and Guide) without having to delete it from the Step list. This icon  is then visible in the first column.











Visibility

Furthermore, it's also possible to specify for **each individual export** whether the **page** is to be **visible** to the user. The icons in the first column of the Step list refer to visibility.

-  Page is only visible in the E-learning
-  Page is only visible in the Documentation
-  Page is only visible in the Guide

The settings are defined in the properties of a step. These can be opened by double-clicking a step in the Step list.

- **Visibility**
Indicates the views or exports in which the page is visible.
- **Outline and steps**
Specifies the title of the outline element or steps.
- **Type**
Indicates the template or master with which the page is connected.
- **Label**
Specifies the title of the template or master with which the page is connected.
- **Question mode**
Indicates whether the page is a question page.



- **ID**
Indicates the ID of the page.
