Document types, which facilitate the creation of a document that only consists of a link, require a URL repository.

-  URL repositories are special document repositories that have to be set up by your administrator before being used for the first time. To be able to use this function, at least one document type that matches this document repository must exist. In cases where



more than one URL repository has been assigned to a document type, an additional step will appear in the creation dialog. This is where you can select the desired repository.



To make things easier, these repositories are normally created in such a way that the base URL is already specified, so that the document objects only refer to the page on the server.
