

Multimedia

You have the option of using various multimedia files, such as film files or sound files in the e-learning. Keep reading to find out more about the multimedia functions in the Producer.

In addition to text and graphics, you also have the option of incorporating film files (*.avi , *.mpeg) and sound files (*.mp3) into an e-learning. These multimedia files are imported into the Producer document and listed in the list of presentation objects.

Upon insertion, sound files are immediately assigned the **Play sound** animation effect.


1 Sound

The following animation effects are available in conjunction with sound files:


- Play sound
- Stop sound
- Pause / continue sound

Just like all other animation effects, the timing of these effects can be controlled in the list of animations.


Sound files are displayed via a **sound icon** in the top left-hand corner of the E-learning view. Sound effects are indicated by a **little flag** just below the sound icon.



Double-clicking the sound icon allows you to introduce settings for the sound file:



Double-clicking the little flag allows you to introduce settings for the effect:

Please note the following when dealing with sound files: Sounds are played in the Study mode only by default. The placeholder icon for the sound is not visible when the Assessment mode is displayed. However, the sound is always displayed in the list of presentation objects. The list of **properties** allows you to specify whether the sound is active only in the Study mode, only in the Assessment mode or in both modes.

2 Film

Whenever a video file has been inserted, you have the option of specifying that the file is to be played from a particular frame and not from the very start. The scaling can also be specified.
