Trigger object:

To design single or multiple-choice test questions in a barrier-free manner, you need to add a separate animation trigger to each potential answer. **Select choice** is the desired type for the trigger. Select **Upon keystroke / key combination** as the trigger type and assign a separate, easy-to-use **key** (or key combination in conjunction with the "Other key" setting) to each answer. In the case of multiple-choice questions, pressing the specified key will always toggle the respective state of the answer (selected / not selected), while in the case of single-choice questions, pressing the key will select the corresponding answer.
